## Message from The Principal

The weather has not really played its part this week and today the athletics were postponed for the second time due to how wet the ground are. The forecast for Monday is looking good and following what is scheduled to be a dry weekend we have high expectations of running both our TSSA athletics and the school athletics on Monday.

Our school tunnel house is now completed with its raised beds installed and good quality soil added. I know that the Rata hub have a number of seedlings in their classroom ready for planting and it will be good to see classrooms using this new resource. Again thank you to our board members especially Steve Robertson for getting this erected and ready.

The Board of Trustees meeting was held on Tuesday. During this meeting we had a presentation on intervention programmes being run here at Elmgrove and what these cover. It was great to see where the extra money the Board puts into these programmes is spent and how many children are benefiting from this. There were over 60 children throughout the school who have been part of either individual or small group programmes to fill gaps and bolster their learning throughout the year. The board were updated on the current property projects. These include the upgrade of the toilet facilities in the school hall and the scooter track development. The Board accepted a quote for the design and project management of the scooter /bike tracks and look forward to seeing more progress on this in the coming months. A painted track will be added to the junior playground this term also. The Board reluctantly accepted the resignation of Denise Hannagan effective from the end of this year. Denise is taking up a new role as a Learning Support Coordinator within the Taieri Cluster and will be based out of East Taieri School in 2020. The Board want to thank Denise for the many years of dedication she has given to Elmgrove school and wish her well in this new direction and position. We will be looking to appoint a replacement for Denise to start in 2020 during the next month.

We are expecting summer any day now and it is therefore a sunhat term. Please make sure your child has a suitable sunhat at school to wear in the playground. We will now be asking children to stay under the verandahs in shaded areas if they are not wearing their hats. With Athletics day scheduled for Monday we will want to see children with their hats on while waiting for their events.
